

Fausta Guarriello is full professor of Labour Law, Industrial Relations and Transnational Labour Law at University "G. D'Annunzio" of Chieti-Pescara. Former Head of the Department of Legal and Social Sciences, Jean Monnet Chair and Jean Monnet Chair *ad personam*, she has been an appointed professor in the Faculty of Law at University LUISS Guido Carli in Rome and in the Faculty of Political Sciences at University Sapienza of Rome.

Specialist in the field of labour law and industrial relations, also in the comparative dimension, as well as in the EU employment law and antidiscrimination law. Her recent works concern the prospect of mandatory human rights due diligence and the role that social partners can play; the emergency of the right to collective bargaining for platform workers; the change in labour law and collective bargaining systems following the austerity measures adopted in European countries; the process of implementation of transnational company agreements in multinational companies and their global value chains.

Invited professor at University of Sevilla, Paris-Cachan, Avignon, Athens, Thessaloniki during her sabbatical 2018-2019, she's co-editor of one of the most prestigious Italian journal in the field, *Giornale di diritto del lavoro e di relazioni industriali*, founded by Gino Giugni, and member of the editorial board of other relevant scientific journals such as the *Rivista giuridica del lavoro* and the *Rivista italiana di diritto del lavoro*.
